Como você pode observar nos exemplos acima, o auxiliar **did** aparece nas formas interrogativas e negativas. Em ambos os casos, o verbo principal fica no infinitivo.

As palavras abaixo estão associadas ao passado, são conhecidas como marcadores temporais.

Yesterday – ontem I went to the supermarket yesterday.

Last Saturday- sábado passado Did she travel to Miami last Saturday?

Last night – noite passada I didn't sleep well last night.

Two Years ago – dois anos atrás My father worked here two Years ago.
