SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

<u>TO BE</u>	<u>TO DO</u>	<u>TO HAVE</u>
I am	I do	I have
You are	You do	You have
He is	He does	He has
She is	She does	She has
It is	It does	It has
We are	We do	We have
You are	You do	You have
They are	They do	They have

SIMPLE PRESENT →NEGATIVE FORM

→ Usamos o VERBO AUXILIAR **do not (don't)** APÓS o sujeito da oração (**I, you, we, they**) e ANTES do verbo AÇÃO (Verbo Principal) OBS: **Não** há alteração do verbo principal.

Ex: Affirmative form → I LIKE you. (Eu GOSTO de você.)

Negative form → I **don't** LIKE you. (Eu não gosto de você)

→ Usamos o VERBO AUXILIAR **does not (doesn't)** APÓS o sujeito da oração (he, she , it) e ANTES do verbo AÇÃO (Verbo Principal). OBS: **Há** alteração do verbo principal.

Ex: Affirmative form → HE LIKE**S** you. (ELE GOSTA de você.)

Negative form → HE **doesn't** LIKE you. (ELE **não** gosta de você)

SIMPLE PRESENT →INTERROGATIVE FORM

→ Usamos o VERBO AUXILIAR **Do** ANTES do sujeito da oração (**I, you, we, they**) , repete-se a frase e acrescenta-se o ponto de interrogação. (?)

Ex: Affirmative form → You LIKE me. (Voce GOSTA de mim.)

Interrogative form → **Do** you LIKE me?. (Voce GOSTA de mim?)

→ Usamos o VERBO AUXILIAR **DOES** ANTES do sujeito da oração (he, she , it) , repete-se a frase com o Verbo Principal (SEM a reginha de 3ª pessoa do singular que ganhou na forma afirmativa) e acrescenta-se o ponto de interrogação no final da frase. (?)

Ex: Affirmative form → HE LIKE**S** you. (Ele GOSTA de você.)

Interrogative form → **Does** he LIKE you? (Ele GOSTA de você ?)
