### ONOMATOPEIA → Onomatopoeia

**Onomatopoeia** refers to words that imitate sounds associated with objects or actions they refer to.


Ex: **rain** (chuva) → drip drop, plop, splash


- a) The **snake** went hiss when it encountered its prey.
