Do you know William Shakespeare? Read his biography:


William Shakespeare

Dramaturgo e poeta inglês, William Shakespeare (1564 -1616) é, até hoje, considerado um dos maiores escritores de todos os tempos. Nascido em Stratford-upon-Avon, Inglaterra, sabe-se que, já casado, Shakespeare deixa sua cidade natal para conquistar a carreira teatral em Londres. Inicialmente trabalhou como ator, mas logo se tornou famoso devido às suas peças teatrais. Com amigos, o dramaturgo forma uma companhia de teatro, a *Lord Chamberlain's Men*, companhia esta que o aiudou a fundar o famoso *Globe Theatre*.

Durante sua vida Shakespeare escreveu mais de 40 trabalhos, incluindo poemas, peças e materiais hoje dados como *perdidos*. Apesar de sua maestria na poesia, foi com o teatro que se destacou como escritor. Dentre suas principais obras teatrais destacamos *The Taming of the Shrew, Romeo and Juliet, Midsummer Night's Dream, Hamlet, Othello, Macbeth e King Lear*, as quais são, até hoje, mundialmente encenadas.

Suas adaptações são bastante comuns nos dias atuais, podemos citar o filme estadunidense *Ten Things I Hate About You* (Dez coisas que eu odeio em você), de 1999, estrelado por Julia Stiles e Heath Ledger, e que foi livremente adaptado da obra *The Taming of the Shrew.* A mesma peça inspirou Walcyr Carrasco a escrever a telenovela *O Cravo e a Rosa*, exibida no canal aberto *Rede Globo*, entre 2000 e 2001, estrelando Adriana Esteves e Eduardo Moscóvis nos papéis principais. O Estúdio Mauricio de Sousa produziu, em data questionável, o gibi *Turma da Mônica – Romeu e Julieta*, adaptação da obra homônima, na qual Mônica representa Julieta (Julieta Monicapuleto), e Cebolinha Romeu (Romeu Montéquio Cebolinha).

So they marry in secret the next day, with the help of Friar Laurence. That's the beginning of the most powerful love story around the world.
