

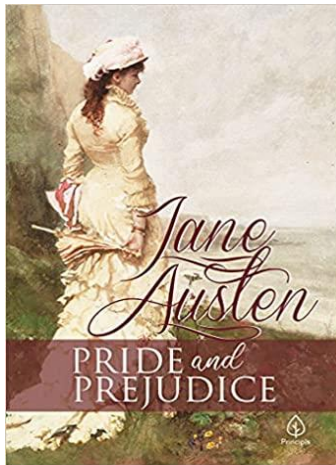

### PRIDE AND PREJUDICE



The book is from 1813, but the story is easily carried over to the present day. The five Bennet sisters were created primarily to find a good husband, just like almost every other woman at that time. They followed a life based on molding themselves to the

demands of English bourgeois society.

Jane Austen narrates, with surprising good humor mixed with criticism, the daily life of the Bennet family, who lived in the countryside. The sisters see Mr. Bingley arrive in the region, accompanied by his friend Mr. Darcy, two young men from London who bring with them, in their luggage, the 'pride' of being rich, with a social position above the girls.

At first, the arrival in the field makes young Elizabeth try to get away from what she usually despises: people who believe they are superior because they occupy a social position above theirs. However, with the proximity of one of her sisters to the young Mr. Bingley (remember that women were prepared for this?), Elizabeth finds herself "forced" to stay close.

This brings Mr. Darcy closer to young Elizabeth, for whom he has had a certain dislike from the start. The feeling is even

reciprocal. She also sees no charms in the boy, whom she sees as a proud man.

With this closer interaction between the main characters, we follow Elizabeth to let go each day, with funny and ironic quotes that show a young woman who is not intimidated. Faced with the approach, the two soon pass from apparent hatred to hidden love, and begin to look for ways to demonstrate this change in feelings.
